About Tempest Therapeutics

Tempest Therapeutics is a clinical-stage oncology company advancing novel small molecules that combine both targeted and immune-mediated mechanisms with the potential to treat a wide range of tumors. The company's two clinical programs are TPST-1495 and TPST-1120, antagonists of EP2/EP4 and PPAR α , respectively. Both TPST-1495 and TPST-1120 are advancing through Phase 1 studies designed to study both agents as monotherapies and in combination with other approved agents, with TPST-1120 expected to begin a frontline, randomized study this summer in patients with advanced or metastatic hepatocellular carcinoma pursuant to a collaboration with Hoffman-La Roche Ltd. Tempest is also developing an orally-available inhibitor of TREX-1, a double-stranded DNA exonuclease that controls activation of the cGAS/STING pathway to selectively induce STING in tumors.
